

UNM Student Publications Board Meeting
Friday, April 23, 2021

Amaris Ketcham called the meeting to order at 4:02 p.m.

Ketcham asked for a review of the April 9, 2021 minutes. Cindy Pierard made a motion to approve the minutes. Adam Lopez seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Ally Wiesel gave the *Limina* editor's report:

- 13 essays will be printed on 80 pages with a signature of Pantone
- PO has been approved
- Proofs are at Starline
- Magazine release party will be a virtual Zoom meeting on April 29

Jeanette DeDios gave the *Conceptions Southwest* update:

- 38 pieces will be published on 96 pages with one and a half signatures of color
- 4 staff members at end of year
- Digital edition is on website
- Magazine release party was a virtual Zoom meeting on April 22

Daven Quelle asked the board for their preference for editor of *Conceptions Southwest*. Shane Farias, Raina Harper, Adam Lopez and Grace McNealy selected Zoe Perls; Amaris Ketcham, Cindy Pierard and Ryan Regalado selected Jeanette DeDios. Ketcham thanked all candidates and congratulated Perls.

Quelle reported that Megan Holmen contacted the *Daily Lobo*, upset that she had not been given an interview. Quelle double checked the job portal, and verified with Student Employment that no such application existed. The board determined that Ketcham would send Holmen an email to inform her that no action would be taken, since the application was not received.
